



Kansas Medical Assistance Fact Sheet: MediKan Program

The MediKan program provides medical services for people with physical or mental disabilities. The MediKan program may provide medical services to people who would not qualify for other state or federal medical programs. Persons determined presumptively disabled may only receive MediKan for a lifetime maximum of 12 months. This is known as the “coverage period” which runs consecutively from the month eligibility begins.

If you are determined eligible for the MediKan program, you must also apply for Social Security disability benefits. You must have very low income and resources to be eligible for the MediKan program. Some resources are exempt including the home where you live and your vehicle.
