NOTES ON CHANGES TO THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE REPORT

All Dates MMIS uses a weekly payment cycle. As a result the number of weeks paid during the month affects the expenditures and consumer counts for the month. Not all reports in MMIS are run at the same time. Therefore, there may be variations in the numbers in a given month in this report when compared with other MMIS/DAI reports.

Expenditures & consumers shown for the WORK Program contain only those for whom received medical services in the month. Other services provided (allocation payments) are excluded as they are not processed through the MMIS system. The actual number of WORK expenditures and consumers are higher.

Some Category of Service Expenditures not processed through the MMIS system are now included in the Total Expenditure column.

Jan-13 On January 1, 2013, KanCare, the State of Kansas' Medicaid program, was implemented. Kansas is contracting with three new Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) to coordinate health care for nearly all Medicaid beneficiaries. The new KanCare health plans are Amerigroup of Kansas, Inc., Sunflower State Health Plan, and United Healthcare Community Plan.

Two new pages have been added to this report: KanCare Beneficiaries and KanCare Capitation Payments (Pages 6 & 7). The Total Capitation Amount shown on Page 7 includes the 3% Pay-For-Performance withold.

The Beneficiaries and Program Consumer and Expenditure pages depict the total number of beneficiaries enrolled/services consumed within a population group. These counts/expenditures include the KanCare populations and capitation payments.

The Category of Service by Consumer and Expenditure pages (pages 8-13) will remain with no changes, other than showing a decline in expenditures as the fee for service payments run-out.
