KanCare What is Electronic Visit Verification?

Electronic visit verification (EVV) utilizes mobile-based technology to validate caregiver visits by capturing visit data as required by section 12006 of the 21st Century Cures Act. KDADS first implemented EVV for Home and Community Based services in 2012. The State of Kansas will launch EVV for HHCS on December 3, 2023.



Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) Systems Must Verify:

- Type of service performed;
- Individual receiving the service;
- Date of the service;
- Location of service delivery;
- Individual providing the service;
- Time the service begins and ends.

The State of Kansas also requires:

• Caregiver observations.



| Step | Deadline |

| Complete Provider Admin Training | As soon as possible |
| Establish Provider Admin (your credentials by email) | November 17, 2023 |
| Set Up additional Provider Users | Anytime after November 17, 2023 |
| Set Up Caregivers | Anytime after November 17, 2023 |
| Caregivers Set Up Mobile | Anytime after November 17, 2023 |
| Begin Processing Authorizations | November 23, 2023 |



| Step | Deadline |
|---|--|
| Capture Visits | Beginning December 3, 2023 |
| Work Exceptions | As soon as visits are captured. Continue to File claims direct with MCOs at this time. |
| KDHE Will track Payments for Matching to Visits | Beginning December 3, 2023 Then after deployment of Claims processing updates. |
| Claims Processing for HHCS in EVV | Required after March 20, 2024 |
