

OneCare Kansas Health Action Plan Portal Updates

Revisions Effective October 2023

- 1. The option "N/A due to COVID-19" has been removed from all fields in the Physical Health section within the HAP. Instead, providers now have the following options to choose from, depending on the measurement field:
 - Not Clinically Indicated
 - Patient Declined
 - Not Available

When these options are selected, the related data fields will be disabled and will not be required for HAP submission. The impacted fields are summarized below:

Measurement Field	Avalible Options
Height	Patient Declined
Weight	Patient Declined
ВР	Not Clinically Indicated, Patient Declined, and Not Available
A1c	Not Clinically Indicated, Patient Declined, and Not Available
Cholesterol	Not Clinically Indicated, Patient Declined, and Not Available

Revisions Still in Effect as of April 2020

- 1. Signatures
 - Verbal consent is acceptable.
 - An example of verbal consent involves the member verbally providing their name and the date.
- 2. Email address for members is no longer required.
- 3. The Goal Number and Goal Description are now hyperlinks. Clicking on either link will open the respective goal.
- 4. The Goal Description becomes enabled if left blank upon saving. Once a goal is entered and saved, it cannot be edited.
- 5. If a Short-Term Goal Description is not entered, then "Short-Term Goal" will be displayed as the default description. This allows partners to access and edit the short-term goal.
- 6. "Not Applicable" has been added as an option under Physical Health Assessing Provider Type. If this option is selected, the provider data fields will become disabled and will not be required for HAP submission.
