OCKP Training Requirements

Trauma Informed Care is the required training for OCKP Team Members. Additional trainings listed below are recommended for OCKP Team Members but not required.

Trauma Informed Care - required

In alignment with evidence-based best practices for addressing trauma and reducing its harmful effects, and as a requirement for participation in the OneCare Kansas program, OneCare Kansas Provider team members are expected to provide OneCare Kansas services through a trauma-informed approach. As an initial step toward developing this trauma-informed approach, team members are contractually required to complete ***Preventing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) Introductory Training Module 1: ACEs Overview and Module 2: The Public Health Approach to Preventing ACEs*** located at <https://vetoviolence.cdc.gov/apps/aces-training/#/#top>.

Training must be completed within 90 days of eligibility to serve members.

Providers are required to retain documentation of training participation in the form of a CE Certificate or Attestation of Training Completion form. To receive CE's for the training, create an account before beginning the training at <https://vetoviolence.cdc.gov/apps/main/account/register>.

Tobacco Cessation – recommended not required

Tobacco use is the leading cause of preventable death in the United States. Because tobacco product use adversely impacts the health and wellness of Kansans, it is an important focus of the OneCare Kansas program. According to KDHE Bureau of Health Promotion data linked here <http://www.kdheks.gov/tobacco/> one in four Kansans uses some form of tobacco including conventional and e-cigarettes as well as smokeless tobacco. Nearly 4500 Kansas adults die every year from tobacco-related conditions.

Providers are encouraged to learn more about tobacco use, tobacco treatment, and secondhand smoke exposure as they prepare to identify tobacco use and/or secondhand smoke exposure in assigned OneCare Kansas members.
