

Application for Third-Party EVV Vendor to Become Authorized for Use with the Kansas EVV Data Aggregator

To be approved to interface with the Kansas EVV data aggregator, third-party EVV vendors must:

- Have at least one client who is a State of Kansas Medicaid provider of services who is electing to use the applicant's third-party EVV vendor solution.
- Commit to and demonstrate their ability to meet privacy protection expectations.
- Establish a valid interface that communicates all required information in the format, layout, and frequency as defined by the State of Kansas trading partner specifications. Verification will come through a standardized testing process.

Interested third-party EVV vendors and their provider agencies should familiarize themselves with the three data submission types, by reviewing the Kansas EVV aggregator informational flyer available at <https://kancare.ks.gov/providers/electronic-visit-verification>. Third-party EVV vendors should apply once they've decided upon their data submission method. After receipt of the application, the State of Kansas and Fiserv will contact the applicant with more technical information and next steps.
