

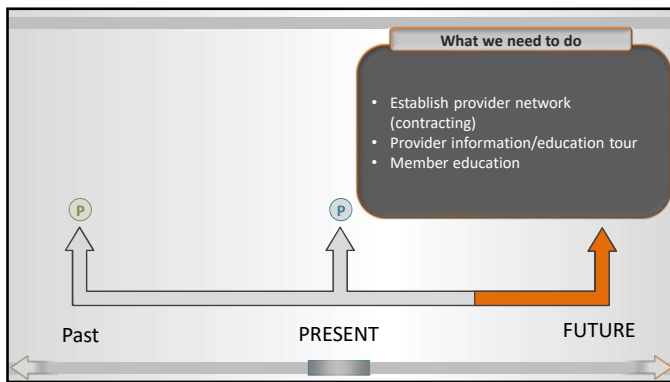
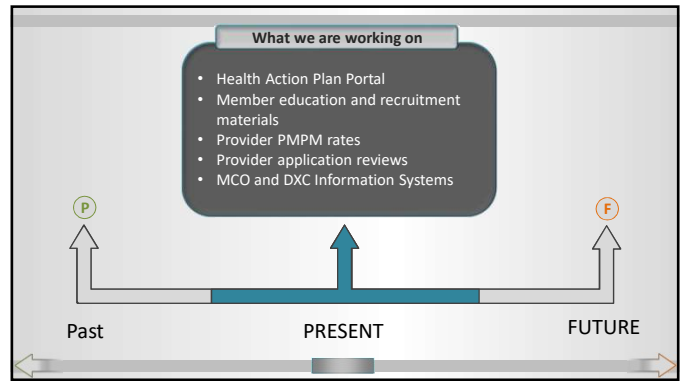

OCK Target Population Selection

Legislative Proviso:

Expenditures shall be...in an amount not to exceed \$2.5 million from the State General Fund...to reinstate a program implementing state Medicaid services for health homes. [During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019]

Provided that participation in such program shall be:

- On an **opt-in basis** and not on the basis of automatic enrollment
- Open to **youths and adults**
- Structured to ensure that individuals with a **behavioral health diagnosis or chronic physical health condition** are served
- Designed to allow any managed care organization providing the above services...to claim an administrative claiming rate **no higher than 10%**

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CMS Requirements for Target Population

- Two or more chronic conditions
- One chronic condition and at risk for another
- One or more serious and persistent mental health conditions

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Target population: The program will be an opt-in program for members with:

- 1 serious and persistent mental illness, defined as having at least one of the following diagnoses:
 - Paranoid Schizophrenia
 - Severe Bipolar Disorder
- Or one chronic condition defined as people who have Asthma that also are at risk for developing:
 - Diabetes
 - Hypertension
 - Kidney Disease (not including Chronic Kidney Disease Stage 4 and ESRD)
 - Cardiovascular Disease
 - COPD
 - Metabolic Syndrome
 - Mental Illness (not including Paranoid Schizophrenia and Severe Bipolar Disorder)
 - Substance Use Disorder
 - Morbid Obesity (body weight 100lbs over normal body weight, BMI greater than 40, or BMI over 30 with obesity-related health problems)
 - Tobacco Use or exposure to second hand smoke




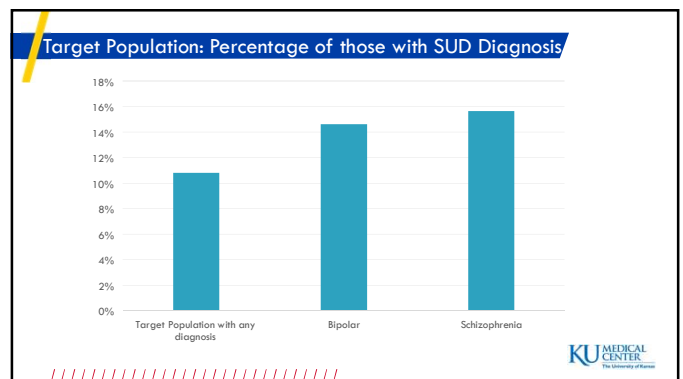
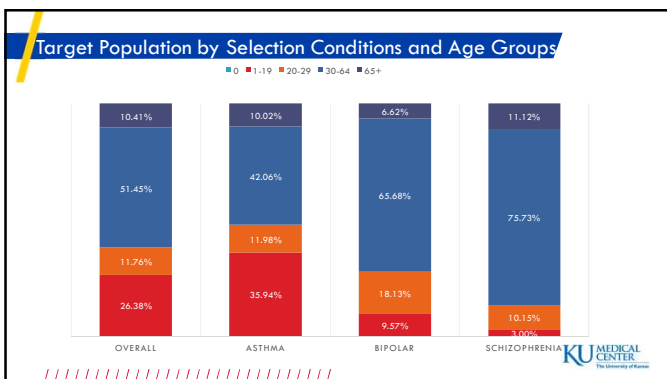
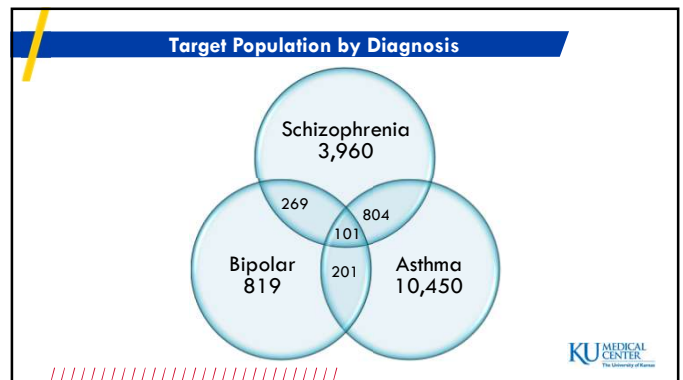

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Health Action Plan Instructions

The Health Action Plan (HAP) is a tool to document goals that the Member will pursue within the OneCare Kansas (1) program. The HAP also documents the proposed process for achieving these goals, as well as progress made in achieving the goals. The HAP is developed during a face-to-face meeting with the Member and Care Coordinator with input from others who are participating in the program of services, and anyone else the Member chooses to include in the process. The KanCare Health Risk Assessment (HRA), a comprehensive assessment of the member carried out by the assigned Managed Care Organization (MCO), must be completed prior to or during the development of the HAP. HAPs are to be updated every 90 days in a face to face setting with at least the Care Coordinator and the Member being present. The Goals and Steps section of the form provides four columns for entry of the initial or annual HAP, the three-month, six-month, and nine-month updates. At the completion of a year, a new HAP is started on the anniversary date. Long term goals, short term goals and action steps may be revised, deleted or carried over to the next HAP period.

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Benefits of Health Homes

- Improved care coordination through multi-disciplinary teams
- Improved care transitions
- Whole-person care through integrated physical and behavioral health
- Enhanced access to nonclinical social services and supports
- Improved patient experience and engagement
- Reductions in ED visits and inpatient hospitalization utilization = lower costs
