Subgroups	The Planning Group may form subgroups as needed to review information and make recommendations to the entire group.
Resources	The Kansas Department of Health and Environment Division of Health Care Finance (KDHE/DHCF) shall provide or arrange meeting space and other resources necessary to support the Planning Group.
Meetings	Meetings will be held monthly and are scheduled for 6 hours. All meetings will be held in Topeka. All meeting locations will be accessible. A conference line will be available, but members are strongly encouraged to attend in person whenever possible.
