<b>Review of Minutes &amp; Introductions</b>	Minutes from September 25 meeting  Introductions	Minutes reviewed and approved with no changes. No new members attended meeting
<b>Reimbursement for Postpartum Depression Screening</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Discussion held about maternal postpartum depression screening. Clinical providers document in child's EMR 0-6mo assessments, but can run into struggle with referral for services if mother loses Medicaid eligibility postpartum.</li> </ul>	KDHE to research codes for coverage, and path for reimbursement.
<b>Billing Clarification for Vison and Hearing (what tests count for billing)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clinical committee members made suggestions for KMAP provider manual to be more clear. Made suggestions for codes to be included in provider manuals. Also clarification on which screening tools are considered acceptable. Without some program perimeters, service providers may feel need to only use Denver screen or other tools that are cost-prohibitive or require specialized training.</li> </ul>	KDHE provided perspective that a validated tool would meet expectation of documentation. Will also be able to make recommendations children with One Care-eligible diagnoses can receive additional screening through One Care.

<b>New Item: Documentation/Attending to Social Determinants of Health</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clinical committee members inquiring on agency position. CMS intent to prioritize quality of service over volume, focusing on multi-interdisciplinary interventions for best outcome. KDHE medical director provided recap from attending recent national conference</li> </ul>	KDHE to keep committee updated of additional conference scheduling and outcomes. Issue continues to gain traction in 2020
<b>Providers being dropped from Medicaid provider list – impact on prescription coverage</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clinical providers were disenrolled from KMAP without notice, created issue for members getting prescriptions filled. KDHE clarified CMS fraud, waste, and abuse (FWA) initiatives require providers to revalidate KMAP enrollment. If provider did not revalidate, KMAP program participation terminated with notice.</li> </ul>	KDHE to provide KMAP provider enrollment contact information to clinical committee members.
