



Proposed 1115 Demonstration Waiver Administrative Changes

Program or Eligibility Group to Remain in 1115 Demonstration Waiver

Substance Use Disorder Coverage: The residential substance use disorder treatment demonstration, including additional rehabilitation services.

Continuous Eligibility for Adults: Twelve-months of continuous KanCare coverage for certain low-income parents or caretakers.

Public Health Emergency Coverage for Children: Continuous eligibility for children enrolled in KanCare under the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), who turn 19 during the Public Health Emergency.

Program or Eligibility Group to Continue Under a New Authority

Mandatory Managed Care: All individuals with KanCare coverage, will continue to choose a managed care health plan. The current managed care health plans are Aetna, United Healthcare, and Sunflower.

Managed Care for HCBS: Managed care enrollment will continue for Home and Community Based Service programs.

STEPS: The employment support pilot STEPS, Supports and Training for Employing People Successfully.

Tribal Member Opt Out: Members of Kansas tribal nations and Alaska natives are not required to enroll with a KanCare health plan. This excludes CHIP.
