



OneCare Kansas Partner Training Requirements

Training Overview

Trauma Informed Care is mandatory training for all OneCare Kansas Partner (OCKP) team members. Any OCKP team member providing or participating in the provision of a OCK core service is required to fulfill the training requirements. Additional trainings mentioned are recommended but not required for OCKP team members.

Trauma Informed Care (Required)

In alignment with evidence-based best practices for addressing trauma and mitigating its harmful effects, OCKP team members must provide services through a trauma-informed approach. As an initial step, team members are contractually required to complete the following training courses, available [here](#):

- Preventing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) Introductory Training Module 1: ACEs Overview
- Module 2: The Public Health Approach to Preventing ACEs

Training must be completed within 90 days of eligibility to serve members. Providers are required to retain documentation of training participation in the form of a CE Certificate or Attestation of Training Completion form. To receive CE credits for the training, create an account on [VetoViolence](#) before beginning the training.

Tobacco Cessation (Recommended)

Tobacco use is the leading cause of preventable death in the United States. Given its significant impact on the health and wellness of Kansans, the OCK program prioritizes tobacco cessation. According to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) Bureau of Health Promotion, [data](#) shows one in four Kansans uses some form of tobacco, including conventional cigarettes, e-cigarettes, and smokeless tobacco. Nearly 4,500 Kansas adults die each year from tobacco-related conditions.

Providers are encouraged to educate themselves about tobacco use, treatment options, and the risks of secondhand smoke exposure to better identify and address these issues in their OCK members.
