

Income Conversion Chart

<i>If Paid</i>	<i>Then</i>
Hourly	Hours worked per week, times rate of pay then multiply by 4.3 <i>(Example: \$10hr, working 40hrs week. \$10x40=\$400x4.3=\$1720)</i>
Weekly	Weekly gross income multiplied by 4.3 <i>(Example: \$400 weekly, \$400x4.3=\$1720)</i>
Bi-weekly	Bi-weekly gross income multiplied by 2.15 <i>(Example: \$900 every 2 weeks, \$900x2.15=\$1935)</i>
Semi-Monthly	Multiply the semi-monthly gross amount by 2 <i>(Example: \$1200 twice a month, \$1200x2=\$2400)</i>
Yearly	Yearly gross divided by 12 <i>(Example: \$9500 yearly, \$9500/12=\$791.66)</i>
If Self-Employed	Take Monthly gross income and subtract, monthly expenses <i>(Example: \$1000 month, \$500 in expenses monthly. \$1000-\$500=\$500)</i>
