Income Conversion Chart	
If Paid	Then
Hourly	Hours worked per week, times rate of pay then multiply by 4.3 (Example: \$10hr, working 40hrs week. \$10x40=\$400x4.3=\$1720)
Weekly	Weekly gross income multiplied by 4.3 (Example: \$400 weekly, \$400x4.3=\$1720)
Bi-weekly	Bi-weekly gross income multiplied by 2.15 (Example: \$900 every 2 weeks, \$900x2.15=\$1935)
Semi-Monthly	Multiply the semi-monthly gross amount by 2 (Example: \$1200 twice a month, \$1200x2=\$2400)
Yearly	Yearly gross divided by 12 (Example: \$9500 yearly, \$9500/12=\$791.66)
If Self-Employed	Take Monthly gross income and subtract, monthly expenses (Example: \$1000 month, \$500 in expenses monthly. \$1000-\$500=\$500)
