Reduce Institutional Care utilization	6.3%	3.3%	▼3.0%	Percentage of Health Home Members admitted to an Inpatient Psychiatric Facility.
Decrease Inpatient readmissions	15.2%	12.8%	▼2.4%	Percentage of Health Home Members discharged from the hospital with a readmission occurring within 30 days.
Improve Follow-up after hospitalization for Mental Illness within 7 days	55.2%	65.1%	▲9.9%	Percentage of Health Home Members receiving an outpatient visit with a mental health practitioner within 7 days after discharge.
Increase Tobacco Use Assessment	6.9%	9.0%	▲2.1%	Percentage of Adult Health Home Members queried about forms of tobacco use at least once within 24 months.
